At St John's College, we know the importance of technology for creating rich learning environments and preparing students for the demands of the 21st century. To help students use technology productively and safely, we constantly review and redesign technology programs that take into account students' ages and learning needs.

Technology in the Junior School – Foundation to Year 6

In Foundation to Year 6, students start their digital learning journey using iPads with multitouch features. These iPads give Junior School students many chances to build subject-specific knowledge and vital information and communication skills. The iPads are owned by St John's College and managed by the school's IT Team.

- An iPad is allocated to each student for use during the school day.
- By providing school iPads to all primary students, we increase online safety for students and provide a consistent learning platform.
- Students are not permitted to take their allocated iPads home.
- We are an eSmart school; we have an age-appropriate *eSmart eSafe Agreement* teachers complete with the students (a copy is included for your convenience).

Students are provided with an iPad, screen protector and a carry case. Students take responsibility for their device, ensuring that it is collected and placed back into the charging trolley at the end of the school day.

Please Note: Prior to issuing your child's iPad, a User Agreement is attached for you to discuss with your child and sign/verify and return on the first day of school.

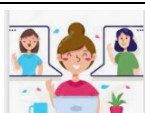
